We're passing along this ~~June 10,~~ 2025 update from the 47th Ward office regarding progress on the Ravenswood Collector Resurfacing project and related improvements to the Winnslie Parkway expansion:



Hello,

The Ravenswood Collector Resurfacing is moving forward well. Having completed **concrete work (fixing and replacing curbs)** on the east side of the street, the contractor is **currently working on the west side of the street.**

North of Lawrence, this involves building curb extensions, as well as moving out the curb farther east – this makes space for the **expansion of the [Winnslie Greenway](#) community garden** south from Ainslie to Lawrence, with parking switching from diagonal to parallel parking.

This concrete work is expected to be **completed next week.** Once that is done, crews will be able to start **milling the street** ahead of repaving, possibly as soon as next week.
